

The Cold Weather Shelter

Come join us this winter as we team with other faith communities to provide food and shelter to the homeless men and women in Washington County. St. Ann will staff the shelter the week of **January 13 to 20, 2019**.

The services we provide are between the hours of 5:00 PM and 9:00 PM daily, except Sunday, when the doors open at 3:00 PM. We register each individual as they come in from the cold, prepare and serve dinner, supervise residents doing their laundry, and chat with them during dinnertime.

If you're an early riser you can help serve a simple breakfast for them before they leave the shelter at 7am. We also need male parishioners who can spend one night at the shelter to offer assistance, if needed, to the staff person on duty.

You may volunteer if you are 18 years of age, or 13-17 if part of the kitchen crew.

If coming to the shelter is not something you wish to do, there are many other ways in which you can help.
