Worship Commission Report: by Danny Burkey

- Commission looking to establish a greater awareness of the Eucharist as part of the U. S. Bishops' Eucharistic Revival initiative.
- Discussion on the subject of allowing for the distribution of the Eucharist in both forms, and Monsignor's options now that the Archdiocese will allow both forms effective with the celebration of Holy Thursday's Mass of the Lord's Supper - but optional per the discernment of each Pastor.

DISCUSSION ITEMS:

Volunteer Coordination Team: Margie Giyurisin has agreed to chair the formation of a Volunteer Coordination Team, to coordinate the work of those willing to volunteer and to connect those willing to those needing volunteers as part of the Parish Pastoral Plan efforts.

Vocation Awareness & Development: The Council was encouraged to consider establishing a "Vocations Awareness Team" to inspire everyone to be more active in supporting folks to pursue a call to serve in a Church ministry vocation; would be desirable to develop a culture that is enthusiastic and positive about considering ministry in the Church as a path for sharing one's gifts and talents. An idea was suggested to consider inviting the Director of Vocations for the Archdiocese to join us for an upcoming Council meeting to learn about ideas and "best practices" that have been undertaken in other places.

CONCLUDING ITEMS:

Discussion held relative to the upcoming Council Information/Discernment sessions on March 20 and 28. Seventeen volunteers have signed up to participate, and names were divided between

each Council member to call Nomineess and notify them of the meetings and what they are all about.
