INTRODUCTORY ITEMS:

Report of the Chair: Darrin Sabol

Report of the Pastor: Monsignor Jarboe

- St. Ann's will have two seminarians again this year: Jacob and Julian. Their focus will be helping with Catechesis and assisting with Faith Formation.
- After two years, it was great to have all ages on campus this past weekend for meeting catechists, catechist and server training, and Confirmation class.
- Over the summer there were two organizational software shifts: ParishSoft to Ministry Platform, and the Facilities Scheduler software updated to Facilities Calendar. Due to the shift in software, the new website process was paused until the switch was completed to ensure that calendaring function would be able to be integrated with the web site.

The Agenda was amended to accommodate the guest speaker, Jim Gullace.

DISCUSSION ITEM: (1)

Planning Process Update: Jim Gullace

Jim shared with the Council a general background of the Pastoral Planning process. Approximately 20 parishioners, with guidance from the Archdiocese, began meeting in December of 2020 for discernment. The focus is related to six Mission Priorities, with several Initiatives supporting each Priority. In June, a smaller Leadership Team was formed to help implement the plan by prioritizing initiatives through specific projects. Once the plan is reviewed and approved by the Archdiocese, the Pastoral Plan booklet will be available to the parish.

Initial activity includes creation of a Volunteer Coordination Team, re-working campus signage, securing a High Places music director, and assisting Stewardship Commission with Time, Talent and Treasure.

Faith Formation Report: by Carly Jardinier

- We are working on planning an adult retreat sometime in March 2023.
- The first 5-week session of the *What We Believe* Video and Discussion Series starts on October 4 (for the Tuesday nights @ 7:00 pm group) and October 5 (for the Wednesdays @ 8:45 am after Mass group).
- The first Family Formation session is this Sunday, 9/18. We had Meet the Teachers, Parent Info Sessions and Catechist Training this past Sunday, 9/11.
- Small groups start up again the week of 9/25 and run through the week of 11/6.

Stewardship Commission Report: by Jim Balog

- (1) "Volunteer Coordination Team": heard, discussed, and reviewed with a member of the St. Ann Planning Team their ideas, and we will collaborate and coordinate with them in any way we can;
- (2) Fall 2022 Stewardship effort: proposed 4 week rollout, possibly beginning mid-September, with first weekend to focus on the "why" of stewardship, the second weekend to focus on "Time & Talent", the third weekend to focus on "Treasure", and the fourth weekend to be a "Summary/Commitment" (parishioners offering their Time, Talent, & Treasure commitment(s)).
- (3) "Legacy Giving" - we are still considering new ideas for St. Ann "Legacy Giving"
- (4) If any Commissions think they need Time, Talent, Treasure during the year, talk with Stewardship

Worship Commission Report: by Danny Burkey

- First meeting is next week. Will be looking ahead to Advent.
- There were 4 or 5 Lector coaching sessions over the past few weeks. Very helpful.
- On Sunday, 9/11, 8 students attended Altar Server training run by Rob Goldsack and Jeremy Newton. Along with 2 experienced Servers. Looking forward to additional Servers.
